Boys ages 6-8 are invited to Audition for the Northwest Boychoir Preparatory Program!

A casual 15-minute audition for parent/guardian & child with one of our choir directors is the first step to becoming a member of the Northwest Boychoir. No previous music or singing experience is required! We are looking for motivation to participate in a choral program, general musical aptitude, and first-third grade reading ability.

At the individual audition, each child will be asked:

- To sing any song of their choice, such as "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star" or a familiar holiday song.
- · To match rhythms by clapping hands.
- To match pitches with the piano.
- Read a short passage from a child's story book.
- Visit our website to watch our audition video to see what it's like!

After the individual audition, the choir director invites a group to attend a one-hour call-back class with the faculty at the Northwest Boychoir to see what it's like to sing with us. Choir directors lead the auditioning group in fun songs, music games, and age-appropriate activities. During this time, parents/guardians are welcome to tour our facility, meet the staff, and ask questions.

After the two-step audition process, the music staff will determine readiness for entry into the Northwest Boychoir preparatory program.

- Entry level for ages 6-8, class size of 15-25.
- Rehearses Mondays & Wednesdays:
 Fall Prep Class: 5-6pm | Spring Prep Class: 4-5pm.
- Curriculum: Basic music theory, sight-singing (solfege), rhythm, vocal training, and fun, age-appropriate songs.
- 10-month class with 1-2 performances before promotion to Intermediate Choir.
