The Northwest Boychoir is hiring a part-time director for its Intermediate Choir, the second level in our auditioned training program for boys ages 7–10. The director leads twice-weekly rehearsals and performances, teaching vocal technique, music theory, and sight-reading using our solfège-based curriculum. Repertoire ranges from simple unison songs to more complex multi-part works.

This position may be combined with our open Music Makers Instructor role (ages 5-6).

Position Details

- Schedule: Tuesdays & Thursdays, 4:00–6:30 PM (rehearsal 4:30–6:15)
- Hours: 5 hours/week, year-round (2-week breaks in winter and summer; no federal holidays)
- Location: University Heights Center, Seattle
- Includes: Monthly faculty meetings; one-week August day camp (9 AM-5 PM);
 occasional extra rehearsals and concerts
- Reports to: Artistic Director
- Compensation: \$50–\$65/hour, DOE (plus meeting compensation)

Responsibilities

- Lead 20–35 choristers in weekly rehearsals and seasonal performances
- Teach vocal technique, rhythm, ear training, and sight-singing using moveable-do solfège
- Select and prepare age-appropriate repertoire
- Plan and lead Intermediate Choir's August summer camp
- Collaborate with faculty and staff on scheduling, curriculum, and student advancement
- Communicate with families and support chorister development
- Supervise arrival and pickup (4:00–6:30 PM)
